Our dedicated team are focused on the delivery of inspiring education programmes and services to schools and communities: Teacher training, pupil workshops, and resource loans are the focus of our work. In the year prior to lockdown, **deed** staff worked in 90 schools training 404 teachers and 181 trainee teachers. We also worked directly with 1,145 pupils and 715 community members across Dorset and Hampshire. Recent successful projects include WhatSUP, Many Faiths Living BetterTogether, Connecting Classrooms through Global Learning for the British Council, GlobalTeacher Award, Positive Stories Project: Dorset's Gypsies and Travellers and Vote 100. We have recently been funded for an ERASMUS EU project and Heritage Lottery Fund recovery grant.

The Board's current priorities are publicity, marketing, funding and networking.

We would welcome approaches from people who have some time and energy to help us take the organisation forward and, in particular, can bring expertise and enthusiasm to tackling our priorities.
