

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<p><u>Introduction to Global Learning</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • In-school/whole school • Twilight Inset • or Half day Inset • GLP Accredited 		<p>This introductory course supports teachers in their work to engage children with real issues and help them understand their position in an increasingly globalised world.</p> <p>We will work with staff to explore global issues, such as interdependence, and share resources to support classroom practice to empower children and develop positive attitudes and values.</p>
